Overland Flow Path

This site (property parcel) spatially intersects with one or more Overland Flow Paths, as displayed on the map attached to this LIM entitled "Special Land Features – Natural Hazards - Flooding".

Overland Flow Paths are lines representing the predicted route of overland flow, based on analysis of a Digital Terrain Model (derived from aerial laser survey). Overland Flow Paths do not show the width or extent of flow.

Overland Flow Paths are based solely on the terrain and are indicative only.

Overland Flow Paths may flood depending on the amount of rain.

The Auckland Unitary Plan contains policies and rules relating to development and/or works within or adjacent to Overland Flow Paths.

Note: The terms "Flow Path" and "Flowpath" are used interchangeably.

Exposure Zones

New Zealand Standard 3604:2011E classifies all properties in New Zealand into zones based on environmental features including wind, earthquake, snow load and exposure. These zones are relevant to building requirements, such as strength of buildings, materials that should be used and maintenance. All building sites are classified as being in Exposure Zones Extreme Sea Spray, B, C, or D, depending on the severity of exposure to wind driven salt.

This property is classified as: Unknown or Unassessed Corrosion Zone

Unknown or unassessed - No known information is available relating to these sites. Recommended that specific sites and/or product designed and to consult suppliers information for specific durability requirements.

Coastal Erosion

This explanation appears on all LIMs, not just sites that may be susceptible to coastal erosion.

The map entitled "Natural Hazards - Coastal Erosion" shows information on potential coastal erosion and resulting land instability, if any, in relation to this site.

Coastal erosion is the wearing away of land due to coastal processes such as waves and currents. Coastal instability is the movement of land (typically as a landslide) resulting from the loss of support caused by coastal erosion.

Where applicable, the map shows lines that indicate areas susceptible to coastal instability and erosion (ASCIE) within the next 100 years. The lines do not show the future position of the coast. Rather, they show the landward edge of the area that might become unstable as a result of coastal erosion. The area between this line and the sea is considered to be potentially susceptible to erosion, or instability caused by erosion.

The lines represent three timescales, and take into account projected sea level rise based on carbon emission scenarios known as representative concentration pathways (RCP):

- 2050 (0.28 m of sea level rise; RCP 8.5)
- 2080 (0.55 m of sea level rise; RCP 8.5)
- 2130 (1.18 m of sea level rise; RCP 8.5)
- 2130 (1.52 m of sea level rise; RCP 8.5+)

The RCP projections are from the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change fifth assessment report (2015), and the related sea level rise values align with Ministry for the Environment Coastal Hazards and Climate Change Guidance for Local Government (2017).

The lines are based on data from a regional study ("Predicting Auckland's Exposure to Coastal Instability and Erosion", available on the Council website). The lines may not take into account local variability, and are not intended for site-specific use.

Development on sites affected by potential coastal erosion may be subject to Auckland Unitary Plan activity controls and may require a detailed coastal hazard assessment report to be completed by a qualified expert.








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Natural Hazards - Coastal Inundation 428 Huia Road Laingholm









Comments

This site poses a number of constraints to its development, which have required the applicant to spend a lot of time making sure that various requests are satisfied. The narrow nature of the site, coupled with the side yard requirements, and building coverage requirements has resulted in the applicant choosing to erect a two storied dwelling in an attempt to best utilise the available building platform. The use of pole foundations, with the parking provided underneath has resulted in the proposed dwelling infringing overall height, elevation height, and height in relation to boundary requirements. But these infringements have received affected parties consents.

The very steep nature of the front (road end) of the property has made the provision of safe access to the site another of the time consuming projects within this application. The original design for the access had to be redrawn in order to meet with safety platform and sightline requirements. To facilitate the access two retaining walls are to be built, one above, and one below the carriageway. The retaining walls will stabilise the fill (from the construction of Huia Road) that is currently on the front portion of the section. The upper retaining wall is to be backfilled, and with the permission of City Infrastructure this area is to be used as visitor parking. This will avoid any possible danger from people parking on the very narrow road berm.

There is a requirement for bush clearance, but as much as possible the development is to be located on the area of the section that has already been cleared. The bush clearance proposed is for the construction of the eastern end on the dwelling, the deck, and part of the parking and manoeuvring area. On advice from one of Council's Environmental Protection Staff the required clearance is to be offset by a condition of consent relating to replanting. Planting on the site to improve slope stability is also a recommendation of the Geotechnical Assessment prepared by David J. Convery of Rock and Soil Consultants, dated 22nd November 1990, and reinforced by a later report, undertaken specifically for this proposal, by Trevor Banks, also of Soil and Rock Consultants, and dated 19 July 1996

The area of impermeable surfaces to be created on-site as part of this proposal is greater than allowed, but is virtually unavoidable. A sealed surface is required on the drive to ensure traction in the wet, and the driveway and manoeuvring area has been kept to the smallest area and length possible, without compromising safety. It must be noted that it would not be possible to gain access to the site in any other manner than is proposed, due to the narrowness, and steep nature of the road frontage. A drainage design has been included as part of the driveway and retaining wall construction. This drainage is to be used to take any runoff away from the road and the impermeable surfaces, and also to avoid any water build up behind the retaining structures. The retaining walls and the drainage have been noted as improvements to the site, improving both the stability of the section and of the road itself. The excessive areas of impermeable surfaces are also seen to be offset by the condition for replanting.

RECOMMENDATION

That, pursuant to Sections 104, 105 and 108 of the Resource Management Act 1991, being satisfied that no body or person is adversely affected, consent be granted to the application by Craig Nagel to build a two storied dwelling at 428 Huia Road, Woodlands being Lot 6 DP 39710 for the following reasons:

- Affected parties consent has been obtained.
- Any possible adverse effects will be mitigated by conditions of consent.

Conditions imposed on the consent are as follows:

- (1) That all reticulated services, including power and telephone, shall be provided underground.
- (2) Within 3 months of the issue of the building consent all access, manoeuvring and parking areas shall be formed and finished in an all-weather surface, to the satisfaction of the Planning Manager.
- (3) The removal of native bush on the site is to be confined to the area of the building platform only, and where this removal includes the removal of pungas under 3.0 metres in height, these are to be replanted elsewhere on-site, to the satisfaction of the Planning Manager.
- (4) A weed-eradication programme to combat the ginger and any other noxious plants on-site is to be implemented and undertaken within 6 months of the issue of Resource Consent, to the satisfaction of the Planning Manager.
- (5) An area of 44m² is to be replanted on-site in order to provide screening of the dwelling, to replace native bush that is to be removed, and to provide increased slope stability (as per the engineers recommendations). This planting is to be undertaken during the next available planting season after construction is completed and should be in accordance with the map attached and marked Appendix A. All plants should be a minimum of 50 cms tall at the time of planting, and should be implemented with an additional topsoil mix, with planting at a density of approximately one plant per square metre, to the satisfaction of the Planning Manager.

The following is a list of recommended species for the site.

- (6) The recommendations of the Geotechnical Assessment undertaken in relation to the site by Trevor Banks of Soil an Rock Consultants, and dated 19th July 1996, are to be strictly adhered to in the design and construction of this proposal, to the satisfaction of the Planning Manager.
- (7) Before the Building Consent is lodged a consent must be obtained from City Infrastructure to Erect a Structure on Dedicated Road Reserve.
- (8) The building is to have exterior colours with a reflectance value of less than 40%, and it's roof is to be a non-reflective surface.
